Gippsland Grammar Scholarships

Gippsland Grammar is an Anglican co-educational day and boarding school for children from ELC to Year 12. We offer a broad academic education, a wide co-curricular program and outstanding success in the VCE years.

JUNIOR SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS – St Anne’s & Bairnsdale

There are three scholarships offered at Junior School: Academic Scholarships, Junior School Entry Scholarships and Music Scholarships.

1. Academic Scholarships

Academic Scholarships are offered to students who will commence **Years 5 or 6 in 2023**. These Scholarships are open to all students - new students and those already attending Gippsland Grammar.

The tenure of these scholarships is until the end of Year 12 and will be reviewed from time to time on the basis of consistent academic performance. The scholarships will carry between 20% and 33% remission of tuition fees.

Candidates for the Years 5 and 6 Academic Scholarships will be required to sit for the ACER PSP Scholarship examination.

Closing date for examination applications: Monday 7 February 2022

2. Junior School Entry Scholarships

Junior School Entry Scholarships will be awarded to students of high academic ability who are NOT currently attending Gippsland Grammar. The applicable Year Levels for this scholarship are subject to change. For 2023, they will be available to students as follows:

Bairnsdale Campus Students commencing in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 in 2023

St Anne’s Campus Students commencing in Year 4 in 2023

The scholarships will carry between 20% and 33% remission of tuition fees.

These scholarships are tenable for the whole of primary schooling and are re-awarded annually provided that the holders continue to show good academic progress & contribute to School life.

All candidates for the scholarships will sit for an age and year level appropriate examination. Areas tested will be reading, mathematics and story writing.

Closing date for examination applications: Monday 25 July 2022

Examination date: Monday 1 August 2022

3. Music Scholarships

Junior School Music Scholarships are offered to NEW students entering Gippsland Grammar at **Years 5 or 6 in 2023**.

Music Scholarships will be awarded to talented and dedicated students of music who demonstrate strong musical potential. There are recommended minimum standards for Years 5 or 6 (these standards vary dependent on instrument, please refer to the Music Scholarship application document for details) However, consideration will be given to students with limited experience but who show strong musical potential.

Music Scholarships include instrumental tuition and academic tuition fee remissions for the duration of the student's enrolment at Gippsland Grammar, subject to satisfactory progress.

Candidates for the Music Scholarship are not required to sit for the ACER PSP scholarship examination; however, they are welcome to do so if they wish. A Music Scholarship application form must be completed by the candidate.

SENIOR SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS – Garnsey Campus

There are four scholarships offered at Senior School: **Academic Scholarships, General Excellence Scholarships, Music Scholarships and the John McIntyre Scholarship for Indigenous Students.**

These scholarships award between 25% to 100% remission of Tuition Fees. Scholarships are tenable for the entire period of secondary schooling and are reviewed annually on the basis of consistent academic performance and contribution to School life. Please note, the School reserves the right not to award scholarships if the standard of candidates does not warrant doing so.

SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY:

If you are already attending Gippsland Grammar scholarships are open to students who will enter Years 7 OR 11 in 2023 (Academic and General Excellence) or Year 7 TO 11 (Music and John McIntyre)
If you are NOT a current student at Gippsland Grammar scholarships are open to students who will enter Years 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 in 2023.

1. Academic Scholarships:

The School will award scholarships to students of outstanding academic ability.

The tenure of these scholarships is until the end of Year 12 and will be reviewed from time to time on the basis of consistent academic performance. The scholarships will carry between 20% and 33% remission of tuition fees.

All candidates for the Academic Scholarships must sit for the ACER CTSP scholarship examination.

2. General Excellence Scholarships:

The School will award scholarships to students who have above average performance in their academic studies, plus involvement in a number of co-curricular areas, such as Drama, Sport, The Arts and Community Service.

The tenure of these scholarships is until the end of Year 12 and will be reviewed from time to time on the basis of consistent academic performance. The scholarships will carry between 20% and 33% remission of tuition fees.

A General Excellence Scholarship application form must be completed by the candidate and submitted with a copy of their most recent school report.

In addition, all candidates for the General Excellence Scholarships must sit for the ACER CTSP Scholarship Examination.

3. Music Scholarships:

The School will award scholarships to talented and dedicated students of music who demonstrate strong musical potential. There is a recommended minimum standard of:

- a high pass in Grade 3 AMEB or equivalent for Year 7
- a high pass in Grade 4 AMEB or equivalent for Year 8
- a high pass in Grade 5 AMEB or equivalent for Years 9 or 10
- a high pass in Grade 6 AMEB or equivalent for Year 11

However, consideration will be given to students with limited experience but who show strong musical potential.

Music Scholarships include instrumental tuition and academic tuition fee remissions for the duration of the student's enrolment at Gippsland Grammar, subject to satisfactory progress.

Candidates for the Music Scholarship are not required to sit for the ACER scholarship examination; however, they are welcome to do so if they wish.

A Music Scholarship application form must be completed by the candidate. Successful applicants will be invited to an audition and interview.

4. John McIntyre Scholarship (Indigenous Student Support)

Gippsland Grammar invites applications for our John McIntyre Scholarship (Indigenous Student Support Program) from students who are Indigenous Australians and are able to demonstrate outstanding abilities in a broad range of areas including academia, sports, the arts, leadership and/or community involvement.

The scholarship will be effective from the commencement of the 2023 school year for the remaining secondary years subject to satisfactory progress and participation in Grammar life.

Students applying for the John McIntyre Scholarship are not required to sit for the ACER scholarship examination.

A John McIntyre Scholarship application form must be completed by the candidate and submitted with a copy of the most recent school report.

CENTRE:	The name of the Examination Centre is Gippsland Grammar , and the actual location will be Blackwood Court at the Senior School , with entry from Princes Highway, Sale.						
EXAMINATION DATE:	Saturday 26 February 2022						
PROCEDURE:	The Examination is timed to commence at 9:00am and candidates should report no later than 8:45am. The candidates are usually busy until about 12:00 noon. Morning tea will be provided for candidates and parents during a break. Candidates must bring two B or HB pencils, a pencil eraser, and two black pens. All the materials you will need, other than pencils, erasers and pens, are provided at the examination room.

The tests are compiled and marked by The Australian Council for Educational Research, which has produced a comprehensive Information Bulletin, which should be read carefully. This bulletin explains how to complete the form. It also describes the tests and includes some advice on how to set about doing them, as well as some sample questions. Additional sample questions for the CSTP test may be obtained by sending the order form contained in the Information Bulletin direct to ACER. ACER does not produce sample questions for students sitting the PSP test. ACER believes that extensive practice on tests of this type will not necessarily improve test scores. The best preparation for a student is to read widely and think critically.

The Co-operative Scholarship Testing Program is an Australia wide annual program of high-level ability tests used to identify academically gifted students for the award of scholarships. The tests are designed to extend students beyond recently covered material to reflect academic potential.

Parents will be required to give a commitment that the student will remain in the School, and in the case of those awarded Music Scholarships, that they will take part in the appropriate School programs.
