WHAT: The Scholarship will be effective from the commencement of the 2023 school year for the remaining secondary years subject to satisfactory progress and participation in School life. There is no fee to apply for the John McIntyre Scholarship. This scholarship will carry **up to** 100% remission of tuition fees, together with part remission of boarding fees.
