DROUGHT ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY

All enrolled students residing or attending a school in the drought affected Local Government Areas (LGAs) are eligible for the Drought Assistance payment, upon application.

Applications are open from term 1, 2019 until the end of term 2 (28 June 2019).

PAYMENT AMOUNT

This one-off payment of \$375 per student is only available in 2019 and will be paid to the school. Families who are eligible for the means tested CSEF payment are also eligible to receive the Drought Assistance payment.

OFFICE USE ONLY:

Government & Non-Government schools:

- **1.** Parents and independent students are required to complete a Drought Assistance application form and lodge the form at the school. Application forms are to be retained by the school.
- 2. The school is then required to complete and email the endorsed spreadsheet with details of students on applications received to csef@edumail.vic.gov.au. The spreadsheet template can be downloaded from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef
- 3. DET will make a bulk payment into the school's bank account.
- **4.** The school will be required to allocate the funding directly to benefit the eligible student. The school should communicate with their school community about how the funding will be allocated.
